The Pathway Plan - across Kaumatua, Pakeke and tamariki. Pathway to employment - Driven from a Rangatahi perspective with an employment partnership with MSD. MSD will sit at NT office once a week. Driver training for school leavers.

Cultural indicators - working with bike riding / A comm e-bike hub / 20 bikes

ACE, library, Carving, Book club, Te Taiao Team, Summer Internship work in progress.

Relationships - Ngati Tamaoho supported the NZ Steel Mill at Waiuku for Industry to get vaccinated.

Vaccinations - 14 August access to Ngati Tamaoho onsite. Email Patsy. Vaccinations will be all day. The second injection will be 3 weeks later, exclusive to Ngati Tamaoho.

Burying of Whenua - Discussions on a place to bury whenua, to plant raakau and look after it.
